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## ***Dr. Terry Copeland***

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Dr. Copeland graduated from the University of Delaware in 1973, with a B.S. in Chemical Engineering. He then earned a Ph.D. in Chemical Engineering from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1978, with a minor in Law.

Dr. Copeland began his professional career with the DuPont Company, beginning in Research and Development, where he was granted three patents based on his first two years of work. At DuPont he was responsible for international marketing and manufacturing. Dr. Copeland also worked for E.I. DuPont De Nemours & Co., Inc. from 1978 to 1992, where his positions included Research Engineer, Technical Manager and Manufacturing Manager with responsibility for the output of several plants in North America.

From 1992 to 1995, he served as Duracell's Director of Engineering for North America. In addition to expanding the engineering organization, he was responsible for the program leading to the development of Duracell's on-cell battery tester. From 1995 to 1998 Plant Manager at two of Duracell's largest major manufacturing facilities, and from 1998 to 2000, Dr. Copeland served as Director, Product Development of Gillette.

In 2000, Dr. Copeland joined Millennium Cell, Inc., a development stage company in the hydrogen fuels arena as Vice President, Product Development from November 2000 to August 2003 and also held a role that included Director of Research and Development.

Dr. Terry M. Copeland, Ph.D. served as Chief Executive Officer of Altair Nanotechnologies Inc. from June 2008 to September 19, 2011 and its President from March 2008 to September 19, 2011. Dr. Copeland served as Principal Executive Officer of Altair Nanotechnologies Inc. and also served as Vice President of Operations at Power & Energy Group from November 13, 2007 to February 2008. He joined Altair Nanotechnologies Inc. on November 13, 2007. Dr. Copeland led global operations and supply chain management for Altairnano's lithium titanate battery products.
